

The HSA President Adam Osseiran facilitated the online event. A series of excellent presentations were delivered by government, industry leaders and academic technical experts involved with hydrogen projects in Australia and around the globe. The HSA has reached an agreement with Clariden Global to provide HSA members with access to selected presentation material (free-of-charge). Successful Launch of WATCH2 Hydrogen Cluster




Figure 3 The third National Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Day_2021 10 08
